

Explanation of a Firefly

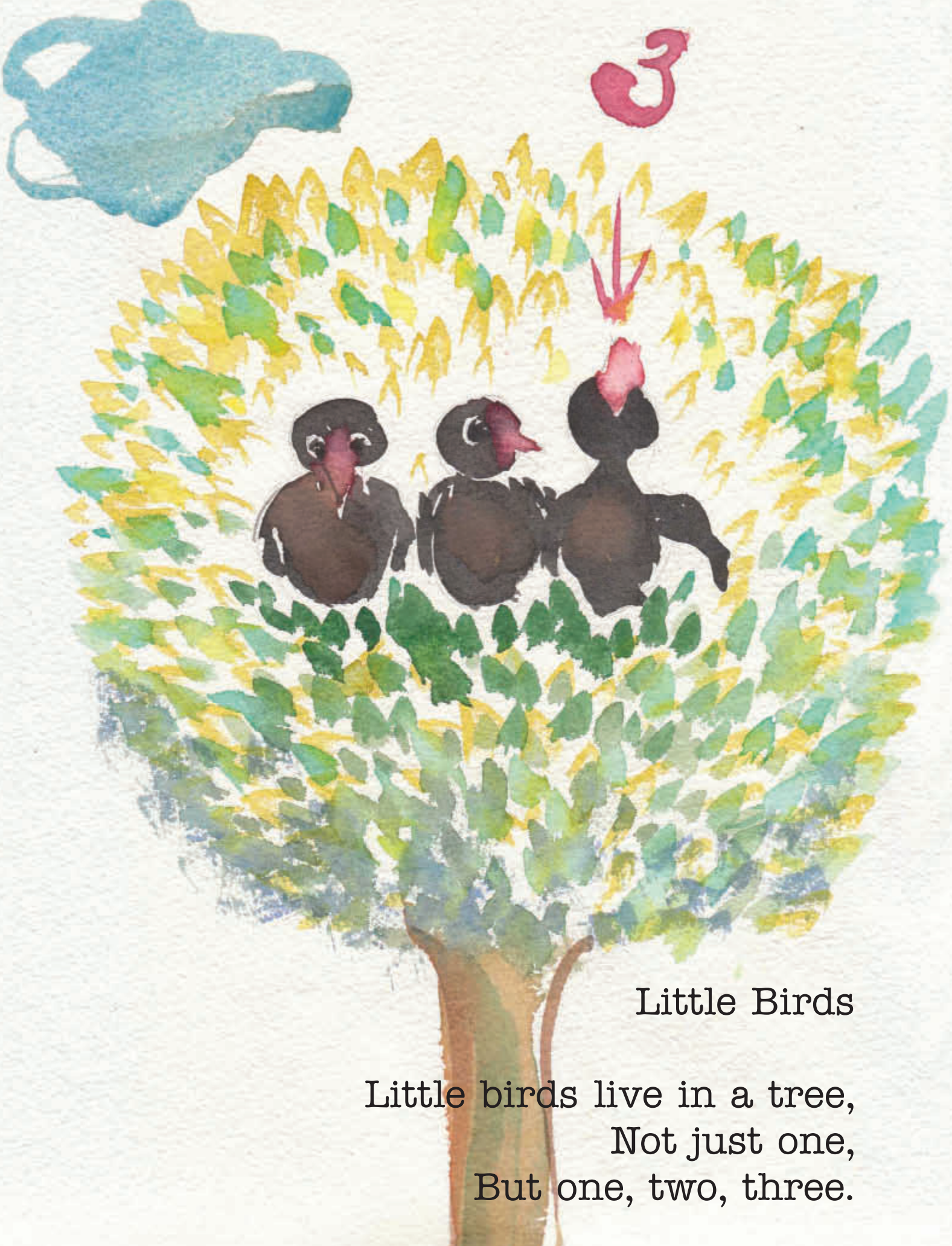
How to describe a firefly?
